Wire Line (Normal Situations)

By fishing with wire line you will double the maximum running depth of each lure using the suggested line length hand rule for NoBo. Then, by simply adding extra line layers of wire you can reach additional depths for each line.

Here is an approximate hand rule for wire:

^{**}The 500 and the 400 Series lures are NEVER used in association with wire line.**

Series	Depth		Layers
250	18 to 25 Feet	•	14 to 20
200	25 to 30 Feet		16 to 20
100	30 to 35 Feet		16 to 20
