## “FALL WALLEYE PROGRAM”



Sessions Lake Walleye, November, Trolling Spoonplugs on Rip-rap

**Terry Velting** talked about “**Fall Walleyes**” for the program. He said that it **may be necessary to fish down 30-50 feet** to catch walleye **in the fall**, although they **sometimes** can come up real **shallow**. This is because the **turnover equalizes water temperatures and the fish can move around more freely**. If one **catches most any fish at 30 feet or below**, there is a **big chance they will not survive** if released because of the **change in water pressure**, so **be cautious and plan to keep any legal fish from those depths**. Terry reminded us to **look for the steeper breaks in cold water situations**. If the **surface water temperature is 45 degrees or less**, the **turnover has likely already occurred**. Chase handed out a **sheet** of comments **about walleye taken from Buck Perrys’ material** and Terry led a discussion of each point.
